DISCUSS AND CONSIDER FOR APPROVAL OUTDOOR YARD SALE/FLEA MARKET ORDINANCE 09062022.

Motion was made by Councilmember Reagan to approve Outdoor yard sale/flea market ordinance 09062022 as follows.

Effective on 09062022 in the Incorporated City Limits of the City of Chillicothe, TX, there will be a period allowed not to exceed three (3) days, consecutive or otherwise, and only permitted quarterly per calendar year, for the non-commercial outdoor sale of furniture and/or household goods. Any garage sale, yard sale or flea market must obtain a permit from City Hall to maintain an extended period of operation. There will be no commerce conducted on property owned by the City of Chillicothe and only on private property with the consent of the owner.

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER FOR APPROVAL PLACING STOP SIGN AT CORNER OF 7TH STREET AND AVE Q MAKING IT A FOUR WAY STOP.


